# 2025 JUBILEE YEAR – *PILGRIMS OF HOPE*

The NZ Catholic Bishops Conference has created a special online page of resources for parishes and individuals to use as we walk together towards Jubilee 2025–Pilgrims of Hope.

Pope Francis has declared 2025 as a year of Jubilee with the theme Pilgrims of Hope, giving voice to his desire for the year to foster a greater sense of global sisterhood and brotherhood, solidarity with the poor, and caring for the environment.

During 2024, the focus for the People of God is on prayer and study. In 2025 the focus shifts to the People of God making a Pilgrimage of Hope. There'll be more specific details about the Jubilee Year when Pope Francis publishes his special Papal Bull on the subject, expected on 9 May (next month). The Papal Bull will also be published on our Jubilee webpage.

“The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire; that is why I have chosen as the motto of the Jubilee, Pilgrims of Hope.” – Pope Francis.

## **DECLARATION: *DIGNITAS INFINITA, ON HUMAN DIGNITY***

The Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith has published a new Declaration on the theme of human dignity, addressing a many contemporary moral and social issues.

The document, Declaration Dignitas Infinita, on Human Dignity, addresses such issues as poverty, war, the travail of migrants, human trafficking, sexual abuse, violence against women, abortion, surrogacy, euthanasia/assisted suicide, the marginalising of people with disabilities, gender theory, sex change and digital violence.

## **PROLIFE FACTS**

The Creation Museum in the US state of Kentucky is a state-of-the-art museum that has attracted millions of visitors. It has an amazing array of displays, from a planetarium, botanical gardens and a zip-line adventure course. Through exploring the museum, visitors are helped to “see how God’s Word provides the big-picture answers for our most difficult questions, whether about science, the Bible, or our personal relationship with God.” One of the exhibits is entitled “Fearfully & Wonderfully Made”. This exhibit focuses on both scientific and Biblical truth about life in the womb, with breath-taking life-like models of preborn babies. A special lighting effect called “Pepper’s Effect” enables visitors to get an inside view of the development the preborn baby is experiencing, including the growth of its bones and internal organs. Other parts of the exhibit include fascinating animations explaining what happens from the moment of fertilisation until birth. The exhibit promotes a sense of wonder for every human life from the moment of fertilisation, made in the image and likeness of God.
