OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

October 7th

Come and pray all Four Mysteries (20 decades) of the Holy Rosary, **Monday 7 Oct, 5:30pm at St Joseph's Cathedral, Dunedin.** We would love you to join us for part or this all of special event. This will occur during Exposition and conclude with Benediction. We will be praying for our Bishops, Priests and vocations to Holy Orders and Religious life.

Millions of people from around the world are expected to prepare for the Holy Year by praying the Rosary on the first-ever World Rosary 7 Oct this year. The event is a response to the request of Pope Francis' call to "dedicate the year preceding the Jubilee event, 2024, to a great 'symphony' of prayer". Many parishes, confraternities, sanctuaries, religious orders and other lay associations have already signed up for the global event. In Italy, at 7pm Archbishop Rolandas Makrickas will lead the recitation of the Rosary in Latin at the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major, in the chapel of the Salus Populi Romani, a place of special spiritual significance ahead of the Jubilee. Students from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome (the Angelicum) will walk in procession to the Basilica, leaving the Angelicum at 6pm. www.worldrosaryday.com

MARCH FOR LIFE – CHRISTCHURCH

Saturday 28th September 2024, starting at Victoria Square and marching through the CBD for about 30 minutes, before returning to Victoria Square, to hear from Pro-Life speakers, including former National MP Simon O’Connor. Mr Paulo Garcia MP for New Lynn, is also attending the event. The key purposes of the March for Life are to call for the repeal of both the Abortion Legislation Act (2020) and the End of Life Choice Act (2019).

We will be gathering from 1pm and marching at 2pm, before hearing from Pro-Life leaders with the event finishing around 3:30pm. Chairs will be provided at the square for those who do not wish to take part in the walk part of the march. We have 400 placards prepared for people to carry. The event will have entertainment for children including face painting, balloon shows, free candyfloss and popcorn, and arts and crafts. There will also be live music from a local church worship band.
