ADVENT APPEAL – CATHOLIC CARING FOUNDATION

Each year around August there is an appeal for the Catholic Caring Foundation and in December, an Advent Appeal. This year the Caring Foundation Appeal did not take place because of the Planned Giving Appeal happening at the same time. It has been decided that it makes sense to combine these two appeals so that the Advent Appeal (which raises funds so that the bishop can give support to groups like the Hospice, Pregnancy Help and Refugee support) would become the Catholic Caring Foundation Appeal which exists to support the outreach of the Church and can include supporting groups that the Advent Appeal has traditionally supported.

This year proceeds from the Catholic Caring Foundation Appeal will go toward the Southland and Otago Hospices, Dunedin Night Shelter and to help establish Catholic Social Services in Invercargill.
