## PARISH INSURANCES

During the past weeks Parish Finance Committee members have been meeting with Diocesan Representatives to consider the reality that our insurance costs are about to increase by approx. 27%, at a minimum, for the period beginning May 2024. Therefore, the Diocese would like us all to consider the proposal of not formally insuring our builds. Instead, Parishes would save the annual premiums that would have been spent (inflation adjusted) each year as a form of self-insurance. This proposal is explained in the video link below and will also be shown at the end of all Parish Masses this weekend.
